

# MAKE YOUR OWN Flower Crowns

## What you'll need:

White card  
Double-sided sticky tape or pva glue  
Pens  
Fallen leaves, or dead-headed flowers  
Grass and small twigs

## Method:

- 1** Draw a jagged shape along the length of a long piece of card and cut out the shape.
- 2** Wrap the crown shape around your head until it fits tightly and pinch where the tightest point is when removing the crown. Mark this point and tape the area together from the inside.
- 3** Gather natural materials such as twigs and fallen leaves. Try collecting small flowers (but only if the plants need dead-heading), grass and small twigs.
- 4** Add double-sided sticky tape (or pva glue) around the crown and arrange your natural materials evenly and decoratively.
- 5** Wait for the glue to dry, or gently press the materials onto the sticky tape until they stick. Try to lift the crown onto your head and see how it looks. Add more tape or glue if any areas have fallen.
- 6** Try making these at parties or festive occasions. See what nature has to offer across the seasons and make a crown for every time of year!
